


WHAT IS THE MODERN HISTORY?

At the beggining of this period, the Catholic kings govern Spain. With their marriage, the kingdoms of Spain unite and they form the Castilian-Aragonese crown.








MAIN CHARACTERISTICS

 They are merchants.






THE JOBS OF THE MODERN HISTORY

After, they move with their merchandise from place to


place and sold their products in fairs.

new food dried fruit from America


WHAT ABOUT THE TOOLS?


In this period, there are many scientific inventions.

The humans invent the telescope (1608 dC). It is an optical instrument that is used to observe distant objects, especially the stars.










The first steam engine appears (1784 dC). It is a motor that is used to move the first trains in the Contemporary history, for example.

The thermometer is useful to measure temperatures.




ORGANIZATION OF THE MODERN HISTORY PEOPLE

This happens because the marriage between the Catholic kings unite all the kingdoms.






There is new food... With the discovery of America, the Europeans discover new types of food. People start to eat cocoa, corn, potatoes, chocolate etc.
